# Extension Activity Packet

### Snack: Monkey Bread

Ingredients:

- pre-made biscuit dough (the kind in a tube)
- cinnamon & sugar
- raisins
- pull n peel licorice



Directions:

1. Divide biscuit in half so you have 2 full sized circles.
2. Take one half and divide into 2 so you have 2 half circles.
3. Take one half circle and divide into 2 so you have 2 quarter circles.
4. Your whole circle will be your head, the half circle is your mouth and the 2 quarter circles are the ears. Place your mouth and ears on whole circle, add raisins for eyes and nostrils (press into dough), sprinkle with cinnamon & sugar and bake according to biscuit instructions.
5. Add pull n peel licorice for lips once cooled.
